

## ***How Much Taxpayers Across New York State Would Receive From The Jobs, Opportunity and Prosperity Plan's Income Tax Break***

The Jobs, Opportunity and Prosperity plan is a comprehensive economic stimulus package that delivers immediate tax relief to hard working Americans. In addition to creating tax cuts for small businesses and providing financial aid to states and local governments, the plan gives each individual taxpayer an immediate income tax refund of \$300. For married couples and couples with children, this refund will be even higher. The income tax break alone will provide New York State residents with a cash infusion of over \$2.6 billion. ***The Capital Region:*** According to 2002 annual employment numbers, 504,700 people in the Capital Region would be eligible for the income tax break, bringing over \$151 million to the area.
